

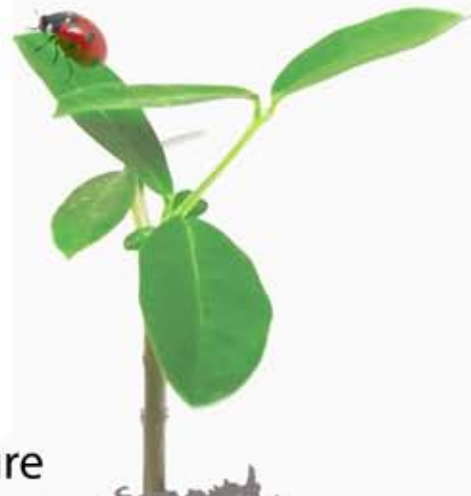

- The Nudivirus Technology commercializes a sexually transmitted virus selected to cause 100% sterility in the corn earworm pest

- Preliminary data suggest the nudivirus technology also sterilizes *Helicoverpa armigera*, the Old world cotton bollworm, which has recently invaded the Western hemisphere, attacks 180 cultivated crops, and causes \$5 billion in damage worldwide
